National Cattle Market Update



- National cattle markets remain historically strong, with barns across the country setting new price records throughout December.

Feeder cattle prices continue to climb, supported by tight supplies and steady demand.

Market analysts anticipate calf prices to trend higher into the first quarter of 2026, though increases may be more moderate than in past years. Overall, these conditions reflect ongoing supply constraints, strong buyer interest, and the record carcass weights reported at the end of 2025.



Ohio Poultry Update

Unfortunately, the HPAI bird flu is still active. A backyard flock in Morrow Co. has been detected as well as wild birds in Clinton and Ashland Counties. We all must be diligent in making sure none of our flocks

become infected. Here are some biosecurity tips to ensure we all stay safe:

- Limit Contact with Wild Birds: Keep poultry indoors, especially waterfowl; use covered runs; protect feed/water from wild birds.
- Control Farm Traffic: Minimize visitors; change clothes and disinfect boots/coveralls before entering poultry areas; ensure visitors follow protocols.
- Hygiene & PPE: Wash hands with soap and water (or use sanitizer after cleaning hands) before/after touching birds; wear gloves, masks, eye protection when handling birds.
- Clean & Disinfect: Clean and disinfect tools, vehicles, and equipment before moving between flocks; use boot baths/covers at entrances.
- Secure Feed & Water: Use well/municipal water; store feed in sealed containers to keep out pests and wild birds.
- Pest & Rodent Control: Implement programs to keep pests away from birds and supplies.
- Monitor for Illness: Watch for signs of sickness (drop in eggs, swelling, sudden death); contact ODA or your vet immediately if you suspect HPAI.
- New Animals: Quarantine new birds for at least 21 days and monitor closely.

INFORMATION:

With a Monday Sale Day, some consignors need to drop off their items on Sunday. Livestock can be dropped off by completing the blue & orange cards located on the dock. Please fill out both sides of each card and place one in the yellow can & one in the mousetrap at the pen you use.

Hay and straw need to be labeled with consignor's name, address, and phone number. We advise placing your paper in a baggy and making sure it is secure from the wind.

There is no early drop-off for small animals or Endless Treasures. All items left are at the consignor's risk.
