### Effective during peak hours (11:00 AM – 1:30 PM):

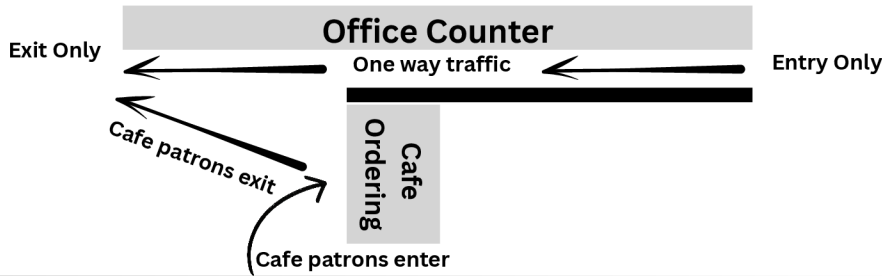
- Enter the office from the NORTH side door

Outside Items: After Hay Sale

Items sold: Tools, household goods, pantry items, produce, baked goods, farm supplies & equipment  
Not permitted: expired food/items that do not comply with ODA/Health Dept guidelines, tires, political flags, baby cribs, car seats, stuffed fabric

### Hay & Straw

Noon Outside

Check-in by 11:00 a.m.

Large and small, square and round bales of hay and straw. Buyer is responsible for hauling.  
Outside Endless Treasures immediately follows.

### Eggs & Small Animals

Begins at 11:30 a.m. with Eggs Inside

Poultry, Rabbits, Turkeys and Water Fowl immediately after eggs outside at the pens  
Check-in by 11:00 a.m.

### Livestock

1:30 p.m. Sale Arena

Check in by 1 p.m.  
Cattle, Goats, Hogs, Horses, and Sheep that are ready to go back to your farm or head to a processor

## SUNDAY DROP OFF INFORMATION:

With a Monday Sale Day, some consignors need to drop off their items on Sunday. Livestock can be dropped off by completing the blue & orange cards located on the dock. Please fill out both sides of each card and place one in the yellow can & one in the mousetrap at the pen you use.

Hay and straw need to be labeled with consignor's name, address, and phone number. We advise placing your paper in a baggy and making sure it is secure from the wind.

There is no early drop-off for small animals or Endless Treasures. All items left are at the consignor's risk.
