**Did you know that you can have your check automatically deposited into your checking account?** Your money is available to you by Wednesday, the same week that you sell.

We place all paper checks in the mail box at the post office late Monday night. From there we can not guarantee an arrival day but hope it makes it to you by Friday of the same week. ACH can also be used to pay for your purchases.

Check in by 1 p.m.

## SUNDAY DROP OFF INFORMATION:

With a Monday Sale Day, some consignors need to drop off their items on Sunday. Livestock can be dropped off and completing the blue & orange cards located on the dock. Please fill out both sides of each card and place one in the yellow can & one in the mousetrap at the pen you use.

Hay and straw need to be labeled with consignor's name, address, and phone number. We advise placing your paper in a baggy and making sure it is secure from the wind.

There is no early drop-off for small animals or Endless Treasures. All items left are at the consignor's risk.
