Noon Outside
Check-in by 11:30 a.m.
Large and small, square and round bales of hay and straw. Buyer is responsible for hauling.

Livestock

1:30 p.m. Inside
Check-in by 1 p.m.
Cattle, Goats, Hogs, Horses, and Sheep that are ready to go back to your farm or head to a processor

Horse and Tack Sales

We keep getting requests for special horse sales with our tack sales. We are going to try it again! We will have one in the spring and one in the fall. Mark your calendars for April 21 and September 29. Tack will start at 5pm and Horses will start at 6:30pm. Weather permitting, we will sell horses outside.

Tags, Identification, and Why

Per ODA and USDA rules and regulations, all livestock need to be properly tagged for disease tracing purposes. This tracking often occurs before the animal enters our facility.

Sheep and goats must have a scrapies tag. Hogs will get a metal blue, silver, or red ear tag depending on if they are feeders, breeders, or slaughter hogs. Cattle receive a metal NUES (soon to be RFID) ear tag if they are going out of state. Slaughter animals are to get a back tag. To add to the mix, our facility must have a method of tracking internally.

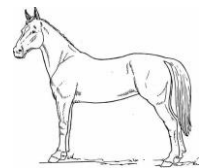
For our livestock sale, you will notice that cattle,

hogs, and horses get a back tag. We use the scrapies tag for the sheep and goats. These tag numbers are associated with the consignor check-in forms and checks, plus the buyer's invoices.

We also use tag numbers as identification for our 9 am Endless Treasures Sale, the eggs/ poultry/ rabbits at 11:30 am, and the 12 noon hay sale. This helps the staff to ensure that each item is accounted.

When dropping off your livestock on Sundays, please make sure to fill out both dock cards. For hay and outside items, please clearly mark your name, address, and phone number.
