# USDA's Electronic ID Rule

Starting around November 1, 2024, new official ID applied to cattle must be able to be read both visually and electronically. Cattle that already have non-electronic official identification, such as a metal NUES tag, applied before this date, may continue to use that tag for the rest of that animal's life.

For cattle, the following animals must be identified with official ID if crossing state lines:

- \* All sexually intact cattle and bison over 18 months of age,

- \* All female dairy cattle of any age,

- \* All dairy males (intact or castrated) born after March 11, 2013, and

- \* Cattle and bison of any age used for rodeo, shows, exhibition, and recreational events.
