1:30 p.m. Inside Check in by 1 p.m. Cattle, Goats, Hogs, Horses, and Sheep that are ready to go back to your farm or head to a processor

Pullorum Testing is Back!

Per our ODA Representative, pullorum testing will begin again. All required poultry must have a negative test prior to being sold at CYA Exchange. If you do not have proof of a negative test within 12 months then a rapid whole blood test will be completed prior to you unloading your birds. Cost of the test is \$2/bird that is tested.

Unhealthy or Nonambulatory Livestock

We will not accept any livestock that appears sick. If you are in doubt if the animal is ill, please keep it at your farm and contact your local veterinarian. Once the animal is healthy, we will gladly market it to our buyers.

Livestock that cannot walk off the trailer on their own will be turned away. Staff decisions are final.

Education and Learning Experiences

Throughout 2024 and into 2025 we will be hosting multiple education sessions in conjunction with the Carroll County OSU Extension Office.
